

RHS Garden Wisley

Line Plus flush fronted system with rural oak finish for a prestigious Royal Horticultural Society setting.

Petal was honoured to have worked with the Royal Horticultural Society in developing a bespoke solution to washroom facilities for the new Welcome Building and Visitors Centre of its flagship garden RHS Garden Wisley, Surrey.

The Line Plus system was implemented with full height flush fronted cubicles in a rural oak laminate appropriate for the horticultural setting. Special design considerations were given in strengthening the cubicles for the area of high volume foot traffic and yet the rural oak provided a relaxed and informal feel for this setting.

The matching rural oak laminate was also used for the removable duct access panelling as well as hand drier splash backs. Corian vanity units were combined with under mounted bowls and matching removable under panels in compact grade laminate.

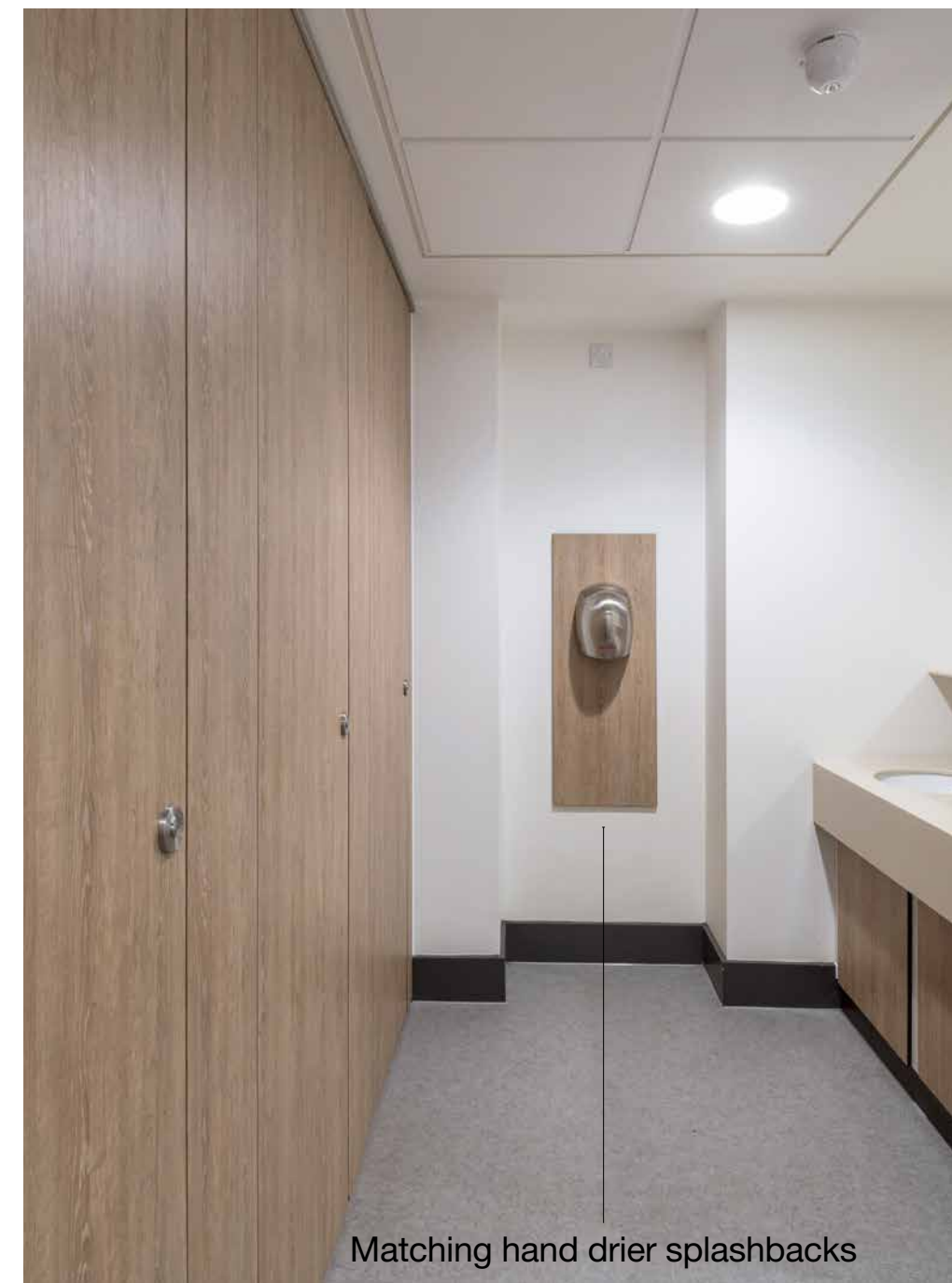
